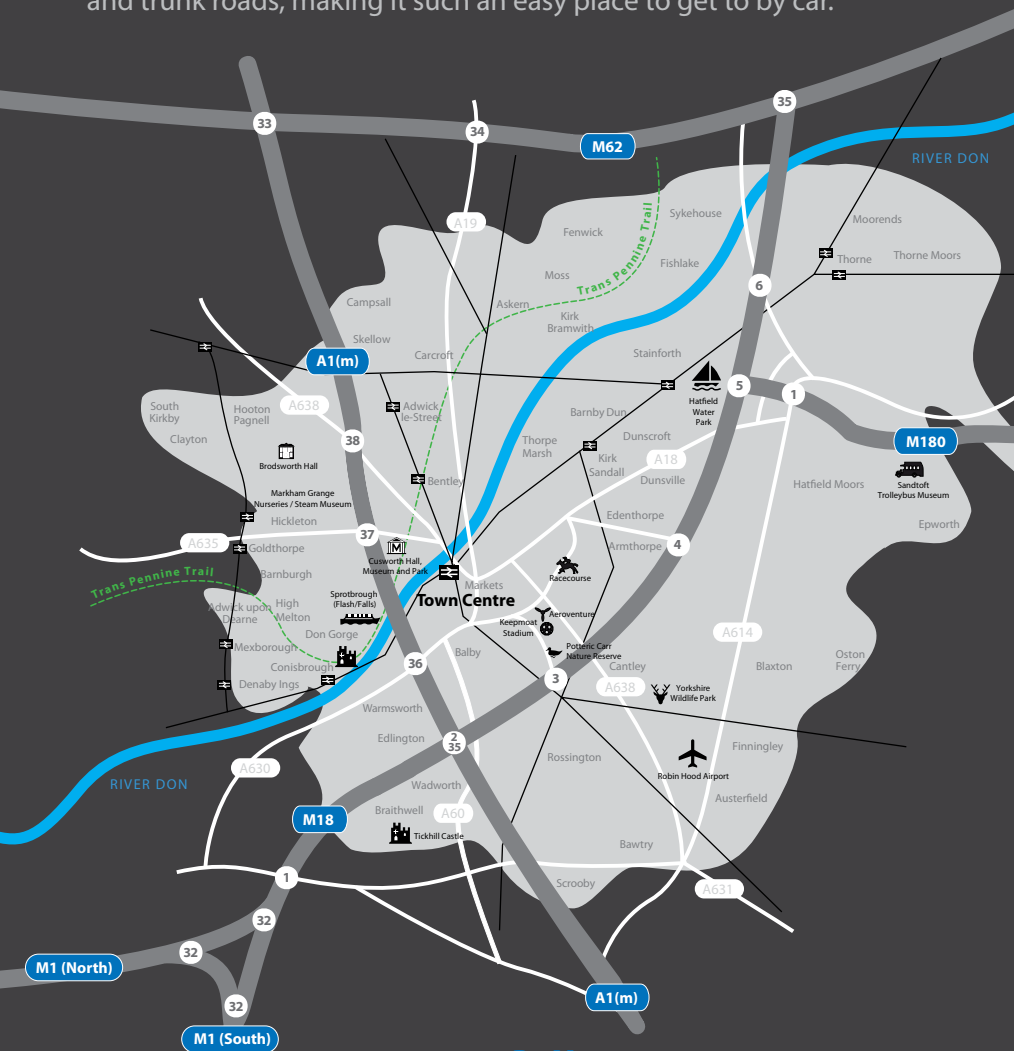

Town Centre

Doncaster is well connected with a state of the art transport interchange for bus and rail in the heart of the town and plenty of car parks – no matter how you choose to travel, it couldn't be easier!

Once here there is something to cater for every taste and every age range within easy reach.

Like the theatre? Then you'll love the productions at both the Civic Theatre and the Doncaster Little Theatre. Both theatres are situated in the town centre with plenty of restaurants, bars and parking all close by.

Doncaster Minster, or the Minster Church of St George to give the full and proper title, rises high above anything else in the town centre and can be seen for miles around, just as it would have done in medieval England.

Shopping in Doncaster is second to none, especially given the compact size of the town centre, offering the very best in modern retail therapy in the Frenchgate Shopping Centre, or the chance to step back hundreds of years and experience Doncaster Market, which must surely be one of the finest traditional markets in England.

We even have a **Mansion House** dating from 1749 - one of only three surviving examples in England.

Doncaster Museum and Art Gallery, situated in a quiet corner of the town Centre, is in fact celebrating its 100 year anniversary in 2010.

And for the sheer thrill and excitement, there's nothing to beat a day at the races, especially during September each year when 60,000 visitors descend on the town for the four-day St Leger Festival, which culminates in the **St Leger Stakes** itself, the oldest Classic horse race in the world.
