& Historic Buildings

If history and heritage are your thing, Doncaster's got it in abundance. Stretching back over 2,000 years, Doncaster's history goes back to the Roman Era, whilst the Medieval period and the 18th & 19th centuries played a huge role in making Doncaster what it is today.

DGLAM (Doncaster Gallery, Library & Museum) is at the heart of Doncaster's history and heritage offer, providing a captivating blend of art, history, and discovery. Housed within a stunning modern building, whilst also keeping the front of the historic 'Girl's High School' this dynamic space is home to a world-class art gallery showcasing both local and international talent. Explore DGLAM your way through their thought-provoking exhibitions.

The airport has also played its part in the cinematic world, featuring in both 'Official Secrets' and the comedy 'Come Fly With Me'.


