As Doncaster prepares to celebrate 250 years of the legendary St Leger Festival, the city isn't just looking back – it's charging forward. True to its racing roots, Doncaster is picking up pace with fresh openings, bold ideas, and a packed calendar of annual events!

2025 was a big year for one of Doncaster's most loved landmarks, **The Corn Exchange**, this historic building has undergone a £5m refurbishment and it's safe to say, it's had a proper glow up! Beautifully restored and on its way to being alive once again with art markets, live music performances and some seriously good coffee; this year the Corn Exchange promises to have a packed calendar of events while adding new independent shops to their offer – quickly becoming a beating heart of the city centre.

Speaking of beats, it's hard to miss the electric atmosphere of **The Temple**, a lively Irish themed gastro pub that is

winning the hearts of locals and visitors alike! Just a stones-throw from the Corn Exchange and right next door to the long-standing favourite, **The Wool Market** – The Temple provides live music, a cracking pint and the kind of welcome that makes you feel like a regular from your very first visit.

It's a mix of old flavours and new faces that keep Doncaster on the map and the good stuff doesn't stop in the Market Square. Nether Hall Road's international food scene just keeps getting better! In 2025 we welcomed the opening of an exciting new restaurant, **Rana's Indian Grill House**, a proud addition to the city's ever-growing menu of global tastes.

If the buzz of the city centre leaves you ready for relaxation, Doncaster has some new spots just for you! Set among the rolling fields and country village of Loversall, you'll find **Loversall Vineyard**, a family-owned vineyard that offers wine tours with a difference.

If you like your downtime with a little movement, head to **Lake-Y**. This new lifestyle resort is turning heads in 2026 with paddleboarding, lakeside yoga, and wellness experiences to help you reset. Just outside the city centre, it's proof Doncaster can slow down as well as speed up. Members enjoy full access, but visitors can try the Padel courts, join events and workshops, or look out for the launch of bespoke holiday lodges.

This summer keep your eyes peeled for the new big cats in town! **The Pride of Yorkshire Sculpture Trail** is bringing a burst of creativity to South Yorkshire while raising vital funds for Sheffield Children's Hospital Charity. A series of lion sculptures will be prowling through public spaces, each one is a canvas for local artists, celebrating community, culture, and the kind of pride that doesn't need to roar to be heard. What's next? Plenty! Doncaster's calendar is filling with seasonal celebrations that bring people together in true Doncaster style. **The Dome** makes a splash with its refurbished swimming lagoons, **Doncaster RLFC**




celebrate their 75th anniversary, new businesses are opening, fresh ideas are taking root, and the city's energy keeps growing.

HERITAGE, CULTURE + CHARACTER

In Doncaster, heritage is about understanding where we've come from, celebrating what we've built, and feeling inspired by the stories that still shape us.

At the heart of it all is the **Danum Gallery, Library and Museum**, or **DGLAM**, as locals know it. It's where Doncaster's past meets its future, with exhibitions that celebrate everything from coal mining to couture. In 2026, a new exhibition will shine a spotlight on Sir Nigel Gresley, the legendary engineer behind the Mallard and Flying Scotsman. Through rare artefacts, personal letters, and immersive displays, visitors will discover how Gresley's genius - and Doncaster's skilled railway workers - helped shape the golden age of steam.

Accentuating the city's skyline with its soaring spire, **Doncaster Minster** is a masterpiece of Victorian gothic architecture and a true symbol of acceptance. Step inside and you'll find a space that feels both grand and inviting, where sunlight dances through stained glass onto intricate stonework. More than a place of worship, the Minster hosts concerts, community gatherings, and seasonal celebrations throughout the year, making it a vibrant hub where visitors and locals can come together.

Just outside the city centre, the landscape shifts to stately homes and ancient strongholds. English Heritage's **Conisbrough Castle** rises dramatically from the earth, its 12th-century keep still standing proud. It's a place of legend and literature, famously inspiring Sir Walter Scott's Ivanhoe, and now brought to life with immersive storytelling - a vivid graphic novel-style interpretation guides you round the whole fortress, featuring builders, servants,



ladies-in-waiting and squires from the castle's past.

Slightly further afield, **Brodsworth Hall** offers a glimpse into Victorian elegance, preserved just as it was found and now cared for by English Heritage. Its faded grandeur and beautifully restored gardens tell a quiet story of time passing, while **Cusworth Hall**, nestled in rolling parkland, brings Doncaster's social history into focus. From kitchen servants to landed gentry, the museum inside Cusworth explores the lives of everyday people - and the park outside is perfect for a picnic, a wander, or a selfie with a view!

If you needed proof that Doncaster's creative spirit is alive and kicking, look no further than the **Right Up Our Street: Festival of Making**. In 2025 the community came together to build a life-sized replica of the Corn Exchange - entirely out of cardboard boxes. Yes, really! A true testament to the imagination, teamwork and pride that runs through this city: making things happen, together. Right Up Our Street have secured funding to continue



bringing community first projects to Doncaster, and we look forward to seeing what they conjure up this year!

South Yorkshire Aircraft Museum is a treasure trove of aviation history.

Step back in time and uncover stories that shaped the skies - from the pioneering days of flight to the UK's very first air show. Explore exhibits that bring to life the courage of everyday people in the Falklands War and the secret world of spies and agents during the Second World War.

It is history told with heart
– and it's waiting for you in Doncaster.


The Danum Gallery, Library and Museum & Cusworth Hall and Park







RUNNING ON DONCASTER SPIRIT

250 Years of The St Leger Festival

Every September, Doncaster hosts one of the biggest events in British racing – and it's been going strong since 1776! The idea was born in the Red Lion pub in the Market Place, where Anthony St Leger and the Marquess of Rockingham hatched a plan over a pint. Today, a brass plaque in the pub marks that meeting – a small but proud reminder of racing history.

Back then, the St Leger Stakes began as a cheeky little 25-Guinea sweepstake on Cantley Common. Two years later, the race moved to Town Moor, got its famous name, and the rest is history!

In those early days, horses might set off six weeks early from Newmarket (on foot!) to be rested in time for the big day. The first horses to travel by van didn't arrive until 1836, a sign of how racing has evolved with technology.

Fast forward 250 years and St Leger is still Yorkshire's only Classic; the grand finale of the racing season and the last leg of the Triple Crown. It's seen legends gallop into the record books: West Australia, the first Triple Crown champ in 1853; Sceptre, who smashed four Classics in 1902; and Theodore, the ultimate underdog at 200/1 in 1822. What a roll call of greatness!

As the race grew, so did its reach. Once a northern affair, the advent of the railways opened it up to national and international visitors. In 1876, a staggering 233 special excursion trains rolled into Doncaster for the St Leger. Race week was party time for the city: until the early 1980s schools and local industries closed, visitors flocked for hunts in the morning, racing in the afternoon, and cockfighting, prize fights, and glittering balls by night.


For the more genteel, there were theatrical performances and elegant suppers in country houses across the borough.

Of course, it hasn't all been smooth riding. Wartime meant the festival packed its bags for Newmarket, Thirsk, Manchester and York – and in 1939, it didn't run at all. But Doncaster spirit never quits, and today the St Leger Festival is a four-day celebration of style, sport and serious fun: Ladies Day, Doncaster Cup Day, St Leger Day, and Sunday Funday.

Each year visitors come from far and wide to experience all that Doncaster has to offer, including champagne breakfasts at The Earl of Doncaster or Relish Bar & Grill, and a host of after parties to attend such as the Party in the Park at The Regent Hotel or St Leger celebrations at the Hallcross Pub.



Why does Doncaster shine during the St Leger Festival? Because this is where heritage meets high-octane racing and a whole lot of community spirit. From Roman roads to racing pedigree, it's magical, memorable, and unmistakably Doncaster. So, saddle up for glamour, grit, and good times – all in one unforgettable weekend.


